COMMUNITY FORUM

The recent process of making the Neighbourhood Plan greatly increased the community spirit and revealed a number of practical issues that are beyond the scope of the Plan but which need to be addressed in order to improve village life. It was proposed that the Parish Council establish a Community Forum, an informal group of people, which could include residents of the parishes, Parish Councillors and members of the Parochial Church Council.

The Community Forum could assist the PC in practical ways and act as a discussion group for community issues, including the development of facilities and looking for an alternative site for the playing field. The Community Forum could also offer a support role to the PC in reviewing and monitoring the implementation of the Neighbourhood Plan.

The PC and PCC members are too few in number to deal with all local issues and volunteers are now needed to form this support group, to help improve life in the neighbourhood area and to continue to build on the enthusiasm arising from the consultation process of the Neighbourhood Plan. OUR DEFIBRILLATORS
ARE NOW LIVE!

The Idridgebay Defibrillator Scheme started by Bev Webster and Hazel Haslam in November 2016, was recently completed with the installation of three defibrillators within the parish.

First Aid & Defibrillator Training for 29 volunteer 'First Responders' has also been completed!

That's a pretty amazing feat for such a small community, so we'd like to express our gratitude to those who kindly contributed to the fundraising target - you made all of this possible.

Thanks also to the volunteer 'First Responders', for coming forward and completing the training - well done everyone!

To further assist, we have pulled together a guide (copy delivered with the Parish News).

The guide provides important information about our particular model of iPad Defibrillator, highlights its functionality, and outlines what you need to do in the event of an emergency.

NB: The publication contains personal contact details for local volunteers; they have agreed for this information to be shared with parishioners, but we ask that you DO NOT share these details outside of the community.

When called upon, a responder will collect the nearest defibrillator, deliver it to the scene of the incident and assist with CPR.

All three defibrillators have been installed in 'unlocked cabinets' and are available for use by anyone; they can be found at the following locations:

St James Church, Cliffash Lane, Idridgehay, DE56 2SH (alongside the Parish Notice Board)

Idridgehay Corn Store, Main Road, Idridgehay, DE56 2SB (on B5023 r/h stde of Corn Store gate, behind the bus stop)

Yards Close Farm, Spout Lane, Shottle, DE56 2DQ (Spout Lane triangle, against Barn Wall)

Hopefully they will help us all to help one another!
