NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN LATEST NEWS

The Idridgehay & Alton and Ashleyhay Neighbourhood Plan moved another step closer

to completion early in June when it was approved and recommended to proceed to referendum, with minor modifications, by the Planning Inspector appointed to examine it.



Julian Jackson (BSc (Hons) DipTP DMS MRTPI)

was appointed by AVBC on the recommendation of the Parish Council to examine the Plan and say whether it met the standards required. He said, "The Parish Council are to be commended on the quality of the Neighbourhood Plan produced and submitted for examination. The document is well evidenced, presented and justified. It follows a logical structure and uses plain English, which should make it accessible to all future Plan users. The Neighbourhood Plan focuses on how new development can be appropriately provided within the special landscape setting of the area and covers a series of topics over a total of 10 policies. It is clearly evident that there has been a thorough and sustained approach to community engagement and consultation.'

The amended plan was formally approved by AVBC Cabinet members on September 2nd and the referendum will take place on October 15th. All those on the electoral roll in the two parishes will have the opportunity to vote on whether to adopt the plan into planning law. This is your neighbour hood, your plan and your vote matters!


