Re: Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) – Request for Information

I refer to your email of 7th of February 2024 requesting information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Your request stated, "I'm requesting audit results sheets for tax year 2022/2023."

Whilst the Act confers a general right of access to information held by public authorities, section 1 provides that "any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled:

- a) To be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request; and
- b) If that is the case, to have that information communicated to him, subject to the effect of the exemptions in Part 11 of the Act.

Therefore, pursuant to the Council's duty to confirm or deny whether or not it holds the information requested, the Council can confirm that it does hold the requested information and has attached it with this response.

If you are dissatisfied with the Freedom of Information response set out in this letter, you are able to utilise the Council's complaints procedure, which allows one right of review for the clerk to re-examine the request and information held.

If you remain dissatisfied with the handling of your request or complaint the Act confers a further right to complain to the Information Commissioner at www.ico.gov.uk. You can also call them on 0303 123 1113 or via email mail@ico.gsi.gov.uk. However, the Information Commissioner will not usually consider a complaint if the complainant has not utilised their one right of review via the Council's complaints procedure.
